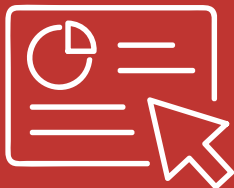

Begin the TAP Process

Begin the TAP Process by contacting the Military and Family Readiness Center 24 months before retirement and 18 months prior to separation. Visit our website: <https://rafalconbury.com/transition-assistance-program/> for additional resources.

IN-PERSON INITIAL COUNSELING

After requesting to initiate the TAP process, service members are assigned a TAP counselor. The service member will meet with the TAP counselor to discuss post-transition plans and receive an explanation of TAP requirements.

Upon finishing TAP workshops, contact M&FRC to schedule an appointment. Final documentation must be submitted to TAP counselor. Signatures from the member, counselor, and commander are needed to receive the DD2648. Must be completed between 90-365 days prior to separation/retirement.
